*Two Authors:* Woods, Erin and Woods, Bill. Bicycling the Back Roads of Northwest Washington. Seattle: Mountaineers, 1996.

### INTERNET SOURCES

To cite an entire Web site it is sufficient to give the address of the site in the text.  
(<http://www.champion.org>).

### PERIODICALS (Magazines)

Author. "Title of article," Name of magazine, Date of magazine, pages.

*With Author:* Tobin, Brian G., "Techniques of Bunting," Athletic Journal, June, 1992, pp. 20, 66.

*No Author:* "Is Skiing Good for Me," Family Health, November/December, 1999, p.12.

### NEWSPAPERS

"Name of article (Headline)," Name of Newspaper, Date of publication, Section and page.

*No Author:* "Cyberspace Clear," The Oregonian, September 10, 1992, p. A5.

### ENCYCLOPEDIAS

"Name of Article," Encyclopedia Series, (edition), Volume, pages.

*No Author* "Lion," World Book Encyclopedia, (1989 ed.), Vol. 12, pp. 298-301.

### PAMPHLETS

Name of Pamphlet, Series, Agency. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright date.

*No Author* Cougar, Hinterland Who's Who, Canadian Wildlife Service.
