Packing List and Tips for Overnight Field Trip

- One small to medium bag per student (labeled with student's name)
- Jacket/Sweatshirt
- Sunglasses, glasses, contacts
- Umbrella (if needed)
- Small flashlight
- Ball cap or hat to keep the sun off their faces
- Two sets of clothing (Dress codes apply)
- Tennis shoes/sneakers (we do a LOT of walking) NO flip-flops
- Sleepwear (Must be modest)
- Deodorant:)
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste
- Over the counter medications to be carried by the student, teachers may not administer (Tylenol, Tums, etc.)
- Prescription medications, can be given by the teachers if they possess a signed medication form from the parent.
- Beverage/Water bottle (must have a lid; NO open containers)
- Snacks for the ride and room
- Camera, we suggest the disposable type instead the family camera.
- A packed disposable lunch for Thursday (preordered lunches will be billed to SMART)
- Cell phones brought by students will be carried by the supervising teacher. Students are permitted to contact only their parents or grandparents at any desired time. If a student chooses to bring a cell phone and it gets lost or damaged, it is the sole responsibility of the owner. Students not bringing a cell phone may use the supervising teacher's phone to contact parents/guardians at any time.
- Students may bring a small throw blanket and/or pillow for the bus
- Pocket Cash (It is the student's responsibility to manage their money for gifts, snacks and souvenirs.)

Additional Reminders and Guidelines:

- No Sandals or Flip-flops
- 2. No sleeping bags or large pillows
- 3. All CDs and movies, gaming disks, etc. must be approved the day before the trip. (Only Erated games for electronic hand held systems, and G/PG movies)
- 4. Please limit spending money. The cost of the trip includes all accommodations, meals, events transportation and gratuities.
- 5. No energy drinks. No Mt. Dew after 6 PM.
- 6. No sprays of any kind due to allergies, etc. Use roll-on deodorants.
- 7. No lending money to other students
- 8. No pen knives, lighters or markers
