Champion Christian Bible Festival High School Guidelines

First Friday in September: Topic and outline due - Turn in to Bible class teacher Second Friday in September: Rough draft due - Turn in to Bible class teacher Last Wednesday and Thursday in September: presentations begin. Late entries will lose 5 points each day for three days. After three days the entry will not be accepted and the student will receive a grade of 0.

Topic: Each high school student will choose a topic from the Bible such as an event, person, theme or passage. Your topic must be approved by your Bible teacher. HS presentations should be at the high school level.

Visual: There must be a visual aspect to the presentation, such as a powerpoint or Prezi, a video, a drawing, a painting, a diorama, etc. This should be approved by your Bible teacher.

Oral: The oral presentation should be no shorter than 4 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes. Your oral presentation should include an explanation of your visual and an explanation of your Bible passage and its application to your life. Remember that you are teaching all of us what you learned in your research.

Written: Included in your written presentation should be:

- A) A section explaining why you chose that topic
- B) Your main content: your research of the person, event, theme and/or passage from the Bible. This should be a synthesis of Scripture and background information.
- C) What is the message for mankind?
- D) What is the message for you?

The written presentation may be typed (double spaced) or handwritten neatly (single spaced). Minimum length requirements are: 2 pages for 9th and 10th grades and 3 pages for 11th and 12th grades. All sources except the Bible should be credited either within your manuscript or in a bibliography. Not giving credit to sources is plagiarism (a form of stealing). Be sure to do research and write about your topic. Don't just copy the Scripture or retell a Bible story.
