Due Dates (Even-numbered years)

1. Choose a topic & turn in project worksheet & sources (20pts) Due second week of Oct.
2. Rough draft of paper – 75% complete (20pts) Due second week of Nov.
3. Final draft of full paper & presentation ready Due day of Social Studies Fair

Format:

Paper should be typed, 12 font with regular one inch margins. Students should not skip spaces between paragraphs. The paper should have a cover page and end with a bibliography page. Bibliography page should be put in MLA style (see bibliography handout.) 9th and 10th should have a minimum of 6 pages and 11th and 12th should have a minimum of 8 pages in length.

Grades 9 & 10 – 5 sources (At least 3 books and 2 internet sources)

Grades 11 & 12 – 7 sources (At least 4 books and 3 internet sources)
