MIDDLE SCHOOL INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FEES (2021 - 2022)

Students to whom CCS issues an I-20 form in order to receive an F-1 Visa through the SEVIS program will be known as international students.

Fees for all First-Year International Students

Families who are registering students must send a completed application, which can be downloaded from our website, and will need to pay a **\$1,000 application fee**.

<u>For new students</u>, this is a required payment before an I-20 form will be processed. This should be paid as soon as possible in order to not delay enrollment. Once payment is made, an I-20 form will then be issued. The remaining balance must be paid by August 1 or a late fee of \$750 will be assessed. Full payment must be received before the student departs for the U.S. or the I-20 may be cancelled. The application fee covers two tries for a visa. If the visa is denied there will be no refund.

<u>For returning students</u>, the application fee is due by the end of March of the current school year. There will be a late fee of \$750 if not paid by the end of March. The remaining balance must be paid in full by August 1 or a late fee of \$750 will be assessed. Payment must be received before the student departs for the United States or the I-20 may be cancelled.

<u>For students enrolling for the second semester</u>, there is an additional non-refundable \$1000 deposit that will be applied towards the application fee for the fall semester.

No fees will be refunded should a student withdraw before the end of the school year.

The fee for ESL is assessed for any student who has not passed the TOEFL exam with an IBT score of 60 or more, a paper based TOEFL of 500, or a SLEP of 55. A tutoring fee will be assessed for an international student who requires academic support when mainstreamed in regular classes. Any student who passes TOEFL or any equivalent international English proficiency exam and does not need academic support will not be assessed this fee. Official results must be forwarded to the school.

Second and Additional Year International Students

Students will be evaluated and a determination by the faculty will be made if that student needs tutoring and ESL included in the fees.

Fees Not Included

Sports fees, music fees, transportation, and charges for field trips will be billed separately.
